



FAIR TREATMENT FOR EVERYONE YOUR RIGHTS UNDER TITLE VI OF THE CIVIL RIGHTS ACT OF 1964

OUR POLICY

The City of Greenville operates its programs without regard to race, color, and national origin in accordance with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act. Any person who believes that he or she has been excluded from participating in, been denied the benefits of, or otherwise subjected to discrimination under any service, program, or activity of the City of Greenville's Transportation Program, and believes the discrimination is based upon race, color, national origin, gender, age, disability, economic status, or limited English proficiency may file a complaint. All complaints will be investigated.

"No person in the United States shall, on the ground of race, color, or national origin, be excluded from participation in, be denied the benefits of, or be subjected to discrimination under any program or activity receiving Federal financial assistance." (42 U.S.C. 2000d) THIS BROCHURE IS DESIGNED TO ASSIST YOU TO UNDERSTAND YOUR RIGHTS UNDER TITLE VI OF THE CIVIL RIGHTS ACT OF 1964.

WHO MAY FILE A TITLE VI COMPLAINT?

A complaint may be filed by any individual or group that believes that they have been subjected to discrimination or retaliation based on their race, color, national origin, sex, age, disability/handicap and/or income level. The complaint may be filed by the affected party or a representation, and must be in writing.

HOW CAN I FILE A DISCRIMINATION COMPLAINT?

WHAT INFORMATION DO I INCLUDE IN MY COMPLAINT?

Any complaint should be filed within 180 days of the date of the alleged discrimination and should include:

- ◆ Your name, address and telephone number. If you are filing on behalf of another person, include their name, address, telephone number and your relation to that person.
- ◆ The name and address of the agency, firm or department you believe discriminated against you.
- ◆ Your signature
- ◆ A description of how, why and when you believe you were discriminated against. Include as much background information as possible about the alleged acts.
- ◆ The names of individuals whom you allege discriminated against you if you know them.
- ◆ The names of any persons, if known that can be contacted for additional information to support or clarify your allegations
